II. RULES and REGULATIONS

- Families and students agree to attend all classes for which they are registered. Progress in class depends upon regular and consistent participation.
- Students enrolling after a session has started may require supplemental private training lessons.
- Families or Students are to notify the administrator and/or instructor prior to all scheduled absences in person, via email or phone.
- Faculty is to be notified of any injuries immediately. Students are expected to observe all scheduled classes during injury and recovery.
- Students are expected to arrive on time for class. Students who are tardy are expected to wait by entrance until invited into the classroom.
- Classical Ballet Academy is not responsible for unattended students outside of their registered class time(s).

III. ADMISSIONS and FEES

Annual Student Registration Fee: \$35

We accept cash, check and Zelle payments.

Payments must be made payable to Classical Ballet Academy, 'CBA', or Zelle: cbaballetacademy@gmail.com Returned checks will be assessed a \$45 fee.

A late fee of \$35 is applied to all payments received 10 days after their appointed due date.

- Registration and Tuition are required of all students enrolled in the Academy Division's classes.
- Tuition can be paid in full or in two installments.
- It is agreed that Tuition will be paid for in full for the full or prorated weeks on or before the appointed deadlines, regardless of any personal absences, injury or school holidays.
- Students enrolling after a session's start date will receive a prorated tuition.
- CBA has a no-refund policy on payments received and no-refunds for dismissal from the Program, or for voluntary withdrawal.
- Classes are subject to change or cancellation if the minimum of five students is not met. In this case your Tuition and schedules will be adjusted accordingly.
- Schedules may be altered at the discretion of the Instructor. The difference or balance in tuition if any, will either be credited or due at that time.
